Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Port Blair Arrival & Coastal Chronicles

Touch down at Veer Savarkar International Airport and be welcomed by your personal tour coordinator. After checking in, enjoy a scenic drive to Corbyn's Cove Beach, a gentle crescent flanked by swaying palms and open sea. Feel the salty breeze as you soak in your first glimpse of Andaman serenity. Later, visit the iconic Cellular Jail, where colonial architecture holds powerful stories of India's freedom fighters. As twilight sets in, witness the moving light and sound show that echoes the spirit of resistance. Return to your hotel with a heart full of history.

Day 2 - Islands of Empire & Coral

Hop aboard a shared ferry after breakfast for a day of time travel and marine marvels. First, step onto Ross Island, once the British capital of the Andamans, where banyan roots have claimed forgotten churches and colonial ruins. Then cruise to North Bay Island, home to a coral-filled underwater world and the lighthouse etched on the ₹20 note. Optional water sports like snorkeling and glass-bottom boat rides add excitement. After exploring, return to Port Blair for a restful evening at your hotel.

Day 3 - Havelock Escape & Sunset Magic

After breakfast, board a luxury cruise ferry (Makruzz/Nautika) to Havelock Island. On arrival, settle into your serene beachfront resort surrounded by the sound of waves. In the late afternoon, visit Radhanagar Beach—its sugar-white sand and sapphire water have earned it fame across Asia. As the sun sinks into the sea, enjoy a professional photo shoot to seal this moment in time. Drift to sleep with the hush of the ocean as your lullaby.

Day 4 - Corals & Calm: Elephant Beach Snorkel

Begin your morning with a boat ride to Elephant Beach, where vibrant coral gardens await beneath turquoise waters. Certified guides lead you through a complimentary snorkeling session—expect clownfish, parrotfish, and a burst of underwater color. Day 6 - Natural Wonders & Farewell Waters

Explore Neil Island’s wonders with a visit to the Natural Bridge, a sea-sculpted limestone arch that changes with the tides. Follow with time at Bharatpur Beach, ideal for swimming or optional water sports in its shallow lagoons. Later, cruise back to Port Blair. On arrival, enjoy a short shopping walk—pick up souvenirs, shell crafts, or fragrant local spices. Return to your hotel for a quiet final night.

Day 7 - Goodbye with Gratitude

Spend your final morning sipping tea and gazing out at Port Blair one last time. After breakfast, your driver escorts you to the airport. With sand still in your shoes and peace in your soul, leave the Andamans behind—but carry their spirit home.
