Drift into a different world at Tonlé Sap Lake, where floating villages sway with the rhythms of water and time. Then step into the divine realm of Angkor in Siem Reap, with its legendary temples — from the smiling faces of Bayon to the jungle-wrapped ruins of Ta Prohm and the magnificent Angkor Wat, a masterpiece of sacred architecture.

Whether you're walking through centuries-old ruins, cruising between stilt houses, or soaking in the spirit of Khmer culture — every moment is designed to captivate, educate, and inspire.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Royal Grandeur & Reflections - Arrival in Phnom Penh

Welcome to Phnom Penh, Cambodia's bustling capital where golden-roofed palaces and French colonial boulevards merge into one unforgettable canvas. After arriving at the airport, our representative will greet you and assist with your hotel check-in. Your cultural immersion begins with a guided visit to the Royal Palace, a shimmering symbol of Cambodia's monarchy dating back to 1866. Within the same complex lies the Silver Pagoda, named for its dazzling floor made of more than 5,000 silver tiles and home to precious Buddha statues crafted from emerald, gold, and diamonds. Next, marvel at the Independence Monument, a proud structure commemorating Cambodia's liberation from French rule. Step inside the National Museum, a masterpiece of Khmer architecture housing over 5,000 priceless artifacts, statues, and relics from Cambodia's ancient empires. In the afternoon, the mood shifts as you explore the Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum, once a school turned Khmer Rouge prison known as S-21. It's a haunting but essential chapter of the country's history — a reminder of the Cambodian people's resilience. Overnight in Phnom Penh with time to explore local cafes or relax by the riverside.

Day 2 - Road to Wonder - Journey from Phnom Penh to Siem Reap with a Floating Village Experience

After breakfast, your road adventure across the heart of Cambodia begins. Travel along the No. 6A highway, crossing three distinct provinces that offer glimpses into rural life — from lush rice paddies to roadside markets bustling with local energy. Your first stop is in Skun District, famously known for its fried spiders, considered both a delicacy and traditional medicine. Whether you try them or just take a photo, it's a story you'll never

forget. Continue toward Kampong Thom for a short refreshment break, then journey along the eastern edge of Tonlé Sap Lake. The scenery transforms as you approach Chong Kneas, a mesmerizing village perched entirely on stilts above the water. Here, board a private boat and glide past floating schools, houses, and marketplaces where daily life unfolds gently on the water. Watch fishermen cast nets and children paddle to school as the sun glistens on the lake's surface. This authentic, untouched slice of Cambodia offers an unforgettable peek into a unique aquatic lifestyle. Arrive in Siem Reap by evening and check into your hotel, where you can rest or explore the lively night markets and eateries.

Day 3 - Temples Through Time - Angkor Thom, Ta Prohm & the Mighty Angkor Wat

Today is the pinnacle of your Cambodian adventure — a full day dedicated to exploring the ancient temples of the Angkor Archaeological Park. Begin your journey at the mysterious West Gate of Angkor Thom, a tranquil entry point away from the crowds. Enter the ancient royal city, once the capital of the Khmer Empire, and be captivated by the awe-inspiring Bayon Temple. Its 54 towers are carved with over 200 enigmatic smiling faces of Avalokiteshvara, watching you from every angle. Wander through the sacred halls of Baphuon and the ancient royal palace Phimeanakas, then walk along the Elephant Terrace, a grand stage once used for public ceremonies and royal audiences. Deep within the forest lies Preah Palilay, a quiet and spiritual site where monks still offer blessings to passing travelers.
Next, visit the world-famous Ta Prohm, known for its surreal, jungle-choked ruins made iconic by the film Tomb Raider. Here, trees burst through centuries-old walls and roots snake through carvings — a powerful symbol of nature's reign over man-made glory.
Your day ends with the crown jewel: Angkor Wat. As the largest religious monument in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Angkor Wat is breathtaking in its scale, detail, and spiritual energy. Stroll along its endless bas-reliefs that tell epic tales from Hindu mythology and admire the grandeur of its lotus-shaped towers. Return to your hotel inspired, humbled, and full of wonder.

Day 4 - Farewell Kingdom - Return to Phnom Penh for Departure

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on your private overland transfer back to Phnom Penh (approximately 6 hours). This scenic drive is a final opportunity to

soak in Cambodia's countryside as rice fields roll past, water buffalo wade through ponds, and locals tend to their roadside stalls. Reflect on the journey you've just taken — from royal capitals to sacred temples, floating villages to jungle-wrapped ruins — each day a chapter in Cambodia's rich and layered story.
