Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Welcome to the Kingdom - Arrival & Royal Wonders of Phnom Penh

Step into Cambodia's soulful capital where heritage meets modern vibrance. Upon arrival, your guide will meet you and begin your Phnom Penh city discovery. You'll explore the Royal Palace, built in 1866, a spectacular compound of traditional Khmer architecture and home to the King of Cambodia. Nearby lies the Silver Pagoda, glistening with over 5,000 silver floor tiles and home to a priceless collection of Buddha statues carved from emerald, gold, and adorned with diamonds. Continue to the Independence Monument, a striking lotus-inspired structure honoring the country's hard-won freedom from colonial rule. At the National Museum, housed in an elegant red sandstone building, browse through over 5,000 ancient Khmer artifacts showcasing Cambodia's artistic brilliance.

br>In the afternoon, brace for an emotional visit to Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum (S-21), a sobering reminder of the country's recent dark past during the Khmer Rouge era. Once a school turned torture center, its exhibits are a haunting tribute to the strength and spirit of the Cambodian people. Rest for the night in Phnom Penh, where riverfront cafés and lively markets await if you wish to explore.

Day 2 - Road to Ruins - Overland to Siem Reap & The Magic of Angkor

After breakfast, depart Phnom Penh for a scenic road journey northward toward Siem Reap. Travel along National Route 6A, crossing through three of Cambodia's charming provinces. En route, stop at Skun District—famous for its bizarre local delicacy: fried tarantulas. Whether you sample or just snap a photo, it's an unforgettable experience. Another short rest in Kampong Thom offers insight into rural Cambodian life before you continue toward the ancient lands of Angkor.

by Upon arrival in Siem Reap, head straight to the magnificent temple complex of Angkor. Enter the vast city of Angkor Thom through the rarely used West Gate, offering a quiet, mystical experience. At Ta Prohm, witness nature's reign over stone as banyan trees consume the temple ruins—a dreamlike scene immortalized in Tomb Raider. Finally, step into the breathtaking splendor of Angkor Wat. This monumental structure, with its five lotus-shaped towers and legendary bas-reliefs, narrates scenes from Hindu mythology and stands as Cambodia's proud symbol of heritage. Spend the evening at leisure or explore the vibrant night markets of Siem Reap.

Day 3 - Departure Day - Journey Back with Timeless Memories

After breakfast, it's time to say goodbye. Your private transfer will take you from Siem Reap back to Phnom Penh Airport (approximately 6 hours), offering one last look at Cambodia's countryside. Reflect on your journey—from regal Phnom Penh to the mystical ruins of Angkor—as you prepare to depart for your next destination. Until we meet again in the Kingdom of Wonder.
