Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Welcome to Delhi - Capital of Contrasts

Arrive in Delhi, where India's ancient soul meets its modern face. You'll be transferred to your hotel. Relax or enjoy a casual evening walk near India Gate or Connaught Place, soaking in the capital's cosmopolitan buzz and colonial charm.
□□ Overnight stay in Delhi.

Day 2 - Mughal Majesty Meets Modern Pulse - Delhi Exploration

Begin your exploration with Old Delhi: marvel at Jama Masjid, India's largest mosque, and take a rickshaw ride through the colorful chaos of Chandni Chowk. Visit Raj Ghat, the memorial of Mahatma Gandhi.
Later, head to New Delhi, visiting Qutub Minar, Humayun's Tomb, and driving past India Gate, President's House, and Parliament.
□□ Overnight stay in Delhi.

Day 3 - The Eternal Emblem of Love - Agra & Taj Mahal

Travel to Agra and check into your hotel. Visit the Taj Mahal, a monument of love and eternal beauty. Continue to the grand Agra Fort, where red sandstone walls hide palatial chambers and royal courtyards.
Enjoy sunset views from Mehtab Bagh, across the Yamuna River.
□□ Overnight stay in Agra.

Day 4 - Jaipur Bound - En Route to the Pink City

Depart for Jaipur, the royal capital of Rajasthan. En route, stop at Fatehpur Sikri, a magnificent Mughal ghost city with ornate gateways and courtyards.
Arrive in Jaipur and enjoy a free evening to shop, rest, or explore the local markets known for textiles, jewelry, and handicrafts.
□□ Overnight stay in Jaipur.

Day 5 - Palaces of the Gods - Jaipur's Regal & Sacred Side

Start with a visit to Amber Fort, riding a jeep (or optional elephant) up to this hilltop marvel. Admire its mirror-filled halls and battlements with panoramic views.
Then visit the City Palace, the astronomical wonders of Jantar Mantar, and the photogenic Hawa Mahal.
Later, visit local temples or enjoy a brief spiritual walk through the old city

temples.
□□ Overnight stay in Jaipur.

Day 6 - Into the Spiritual Heart - Train to Varanasi

Transfer to the station for your overnight train to Varanasi in an AC sleeper coach. This journey brings you from royal Rajasthan to the sacred ghats of the Ganges, giving you time to reflect and unwind.
□□ Overnight on train.

Day 7 - The Soul of India - Ganges & Ghats of Varanasi

Arrive in Varanasi and transfer to your hotel. In the early morning, take a sunrise boat ride on the Ganges as the riverfront wakes to prayers, rituals, and spiritual rhythms.Later, explore Kashi Vishwanath Temple, Sarnath (where Buddha gave his first sermon), and wander the narrow lanes filled with holy chants and incense.In the evening, witness the dazzling Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat—a powerful spiritual finale to your journey. Tour ends with drop-off at Varanasi airport or railway station for your onward connection.
