Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Delhi Diaries - Culture, Chaos & Capital Charm

Welcome to the heart of India — Delhi. Upon arrival, you'll be met and transferred to your hotel. Spend the day soaking in the contrasts of old and new. Visit Jama Masjid, one of the largest mosques in India, and drive past colonial landmarks like India Gate and the Parliament House. Optional: stroll through the markets of Chandni Chowk or take a peaceful pause at Raj Ghat. The capital buzzes with layered history and vibrant energy — a perfect prologue to your journey.

Day 2 - Sacred Rails - Journey to the Divine City of Ayodhya

Wake up for a leisurely morning. Explore Humayun's Tomb and the serene Lotus Temple or shop in the artsy lanes of Connaught Place. As dusk approaches, board your overnight AC train to Ayodhya — one of the holiest sites in Hinduism and the legendary birthplace of Lord Rama. This scenic overnight train journey brings you closer to India's grassroots, offering an authentic taste of budget-conscious travel.

Day 3 - Ayodhya Awakening - Devotion, Legends & Ghats

Arrive in Ayodhya and transfer to your hotel. Begin your spiritual exploration with a visit to Ram Janmabhoomi, the revered birthplace of Lord Rama. Walk through sacred lanes, see Hanuman Garhi, and witness centuries-old traditions being carried forward. By the riverside ghats of the Sarayu, experience a serene Ganga-style aarti — a divine convergence of light, sound, and sacred chants. Feel connected to mythology, faith, and the gentle pulse of devotion that defines this holy city.

Day 4 - From Divine to Dynastic - Ayodhya to Agra

After breakfast, bid farewell to Ayodhya and travel southward towards Agra — home to the legacy of the Mughals. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and explore Agra's local bazaars filled with marble crafts, leather goods, and traditional sweets. Rest up, for tomorrow you'll meet one of the world's most iconic landmarks at dawn.

Day 5 - Dawn of Romance - Taj Mahal & Agra's Royal Roots

At sunrise, visit the Taj Mahal, an eternal testament to love, built by Emperor Shah Jahan for his queen Mumtaz. As morning light kisses the white marble, watch its beauty transcend description. Follow this with a guided tour of the Agra Fort, a red sandstone fortress that once housed kings, queens, and epic decisions. Optional: visit the Mehtab Bagh for a rear-view of the Taj or shop for handicrafts in Agra's old markets.

Day 6 - Lost Capitals & Living Heritage - Agra to Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri

Depart for Jaipur after breakfast. En route, stop at Fatehpur Sikri, a red-sandstone ghost town built by Emperor Akbar. Walk through its courtyards, mosques, and palaces that speak of grandeur halted by drought. By late afternoon, arrive in Jaipur, the Pink City of Rajasthan. Check into your hotel and spend the evening exploring local street food or shopping for Rajasthani block prints, gems, and bangles.

Day 7 - Royal Finale - Forts, Palaces & the Way Back Home

Begin your Jaipur exploration with a climb to Amber Fort, a majestic fortress perched on a hill. Continue to the City Palace, home to royal art and architecture, and marvel at the astronomical genius of Jantar Mantar. Don't forget a photo stop at the stunning Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds). After lunch, drive back to Delhi, where your journey concludes. Transfer to the airport or hotel for onward travel with a heart full of divine experiences and cultural encounters.
