Stop at Hawa Mahal, Jaipur's iconic honeycomb-like palace, perfect for photographs. Your evening is free to explore colorful bazaars filled with handicrafts and gems.

Day 6 - Flight to the Past - Khajuraho's Temple Marvels

After breakfast, travel to Khajuraho, either by train or a short domestic flight (arranged separately if available). Upon arrival, step into a realm of sacred sensuality and exquisite artistry. Begin your discovery of the Western Group of Temples, famed for their detailed and expressive carvings depicting mythology, daily life, and divine unions. These temples are not only architectural gems but also spiritual symbols of harmony between the physical and metaphysical.
