Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Delhi

Your journey begins as you arrive in Delhi, where our representative will greet you at the airport or railway station. After a comfortable hotel check-in, you'll have time to relax before exploring the capital's historical highlights. Visit India Gate, Qutub Minar, and Humayun's Tomb. As you drive through the ceremonial avenues of Parliament House and the President's Estate, get a glimpse of India's grandeur. Enjoy an overnight stay in Delhi.

Day 2 - Delhi Sightseeing and Transfer to Agra

After breakfast, begin your day with visits to the iconic Jama Masjid and the peaceful Raj Ghat, the memorial of Mahatma Gandhi. Explore the vibrant lanes of Chandni Chowk on a traditional rickshaw ride. In the afternoon, drive to Agra, a city steeped in Mughal history, reaching by evening. Enjoy a scenic sunset at Mehtab Bagh with a distant view of the Taj Mahal. Stay overnight in Agra.

Day 3 - Agra Exploration and Journey to Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri

Rise early to witness the majestic Taj Mahal at sunrise, a moment of awe and serenity. Return for breakfast and then visit the impressive Agra Fort and the exquisite Itmad-ud-Daulah, often called the Baby Taj. En route to Jaipur, stop at Fatehpur Sikri, an abandoned Mughal city with magnificent architecture. Continue your journey to Jaipur and check in to your hotel for a restful night.

Day 4 - Jaipur City Tour

Start your day with a hearty breakfast and head to the historic Amber Fort, where you can choose to ascend via elephant ride or jeep. Next, explore the regal City Palace and the astronomical wonder of Jantar Mantar. Stop by the famous Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds) and take photos at Jal Mahal nestled in the middle of Man Sagar Lake. In the evening, you may explore Jaipur's bustling markets filled with Rajasthani textiles and handicrafts. Overnight in Jaipur.

Day 5 - Travel to Khajuraho

After breakfast, proceed to Khajuraho by flight or train (depending on availability and travel preferences). Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and unwind. In the evening, you can attend the optional light and sound show that brings the temples' history to life. Spend the night in Khajuraho.

Day 6 - Khajuraho Temple Tour

Today is dedicated to exploring the incredible artistry of the Khajuraho Temples, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Begin with the Western Group of Temples, including the renowned Kandariya Mahadev, Lakshmana Temple, and others that showcase a celebration of life, love, and spirituality carved in stone. Later, explore the Eastern Group, which features beautiful Jain temples like Parsvanath and Adinath. Optionally, visit the Archaeological Museum to delve deeper into the region's cultural legacy. Return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Khajuraho.

Day 7 - Departure from Khajuraho or Return to Delhi

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and transfer to the airport or railway station for your onward journey. Your heritage-filled tour concludes with unforgettable memories of India's architectural brilliance and timeless culture.
