Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Delhi Arrival & Spiritual Preparation

Day 5 - Agra to Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri

Drive to Jaipur stopping at Fatehpur Sikri, the abandoned Mughal capital. Explore palaces and courtyards with stories of empire grandeur. Evening arrival in Jaipur and check into heritage hotel.

Day 6 - Jaipur Heritage & Culture

Visit Amber Fort, City Palace, and Jantar Mantar. Explore local markets for jewelry and textiles. Attend a traditional Rajasthani folk music and dance performance with dinner.

Day 7 - Departure from Jaipur

Transfer to Jaipur airport or railway station for onward travel or return journey, enriched by spiritual and royal experiences.
