Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Welcome to Hanoi - Dive into the Heartbeat of Vietnam's Capital

Upon your arrival at Noi Bai International Airport, a friendly driver will greet you and escort you to your centrally located hotel for early check-in and a delicious breakfast. Feel the lively pulse of Hanoi's streets as you settle in. At 2 PM, embark on a cultural immersion starting with the tranquil Tran Quoc Pagoda, perched gracefully on Golden Fish Island in West Lake — Hanoi's oldest spiritual site dating back to the 6th century. Next, journey through history at Hoa Lo Prison, once a feared colonial jail known as "Maison Centrale," now a poignant museum capturing Vietnam's resilience. Wind down your afternoon with a leisurely stroll around the enchanting Hoan Kiem Lake, soaking in its vibrant ambiance and quaint shops. Spend your first night enveloped in Hanoi's captivating charm.

Day 2 - Ha Long Bay Spectacle - Sail Through Nature's Limestone Masterpiece

Begin your day with a hotel pickup in Hanoi's Old Quarter, then relax on a scenic expressway ride to Ha Long Bay. Arriving at Tuan Chau Harbor, step aboard the Cozy Bay Premium Cruise for a 6-hour voyage through emerald waters dotted with striking limestone karsts and mystical islets. Enjoy a sumptuous buffet lunch on deck as you visit the magical Surprising Cave, adorned with stunning stalactites and stalagmites. Later, unwind on Titop Island's sandy beach or climb to its summit for panoramic bay views. Adventure seekers can kayak or take a bamboo boat ride around Luon Cave's hidden lagoon. End the day with a sunset party on the upper deck, savoring red wine and music surrounded by breathtaking scenery. Return to Hanoi by evening for a restful night.

Day 3 - Ninh Binh Discovery - Explore Vietnam's Ancient Capital and Scenic Waterways

After breakfast, set off on a journey to Ninh Binh, known as "Halong Bay on land." Visit the ancient capital of Hoa Lu, where the majestic temples of King Dinh and King Le reveal Vietnam's imperial history amidst stunning limestone backdrops. Then, glide gently on a

bamboo boat through Tam Coc's winding river, bordered by towering karsts and lush rice paddies—a serene masterpiece painted by nature itself. Cycle through peaceful villages to witness authentic rural life, meeting friendly locals and soaking in the tranquil countryside. Return to Hanoi in the evening, carrying memories of timeless landscapes and history.

Day 4 - Majestic Sapa - Gateway to Ethnic Culture and Mountain Majesty

Depart early for Sapa, traveling through scenic highlands and vibrant markets of Lao Cai. Arrive in the colorful mountain town of Sapa, home to ethnic groups like the H'Mong and Dzao. In the afternoon, embark on a leisurely trek down to Cat Cat Village, a colonial-era settlement known for its traditional crafts and stunning waterfall. Experience local culture firsthand as you visit artisan workshops specializing in weaving, silver carving, and more. Return to Sapa town for an overnight stay amid breathtaking mountain views.

Day 5 - Fansipan Peak Adventure - Conquer the Roof of Indochina

After breakfast, board the cable car for a thrilling ascent to Fansipan Peak, soaring to 2,800 meters above sea level. Explore spiritual sites, including a mountain pagoda, and prepare for an invigorating trek up 600 steps to reach the summit — the highest point in Indochina. Capture sweeping vistas and immerse yourself in the serene alpine environment. Descend by cable car and begin your return journey to Hanoi, reflecting on the day's spectacular achievements.

Day 6 - Farewell Hanoi - Last Moments in Vietnam's Vibrant Capital

Enjoy your final morning at leisure to explore Hanoi's charming streets, savor a last Vietnamese coffee, or shop for souvenirs. Check out by noon, and a private transfer will take you to Noi Bai International Airport for your onward flight.
