Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Arrival in Mumbai - City Tour

Upon arrival at the airport or train station, you will receive a warm welcome and be transferred to your hotel. Mumbai, the capital of Maharashtra, has transformed from a small fishing village into a bustling financial, commercial, and industrial center. In the afternoon, begin your Heritage Walking Tour visiting iconic landmarks such as the Gateway of India, Prince of Wales Museum, Mani Bhawan, University of Mumbai, Flora Fountain, and Victoria Terminus Railway Station. Overnight at Fariyas Hotel Mumbai.

Day 2 - On the Road with the Dabbawalas & Visit to Dhobighats and Kotachi Wadi

Early morning visit to Churchgate Station to observe the world-famous Dabbawalas, the ingenious lunchbox delivery service. Accompany them for part of their delivery route. Then, board a local train to Mahalakshmi Station adjacent to the Dhobighats, Mumbai's unique and colorful open-air laundry. Spend the afternoon in Kotachi Wadi, a quaint traffic-free neighborhood home to East Indian Christians with roots dating to the British East India Company era. Overnight stay at Fariyas Hotel Mumbai.

Day 3 - Departure

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to the airport for your return flight or onward travel.
