Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 - Welcome to Hanoi - A Journey into Vietnam’s Heart and Heritage

Upon your arrival at Noi Bai International Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by your driver who will transfer you to the city center. Enjoy an early check-in at your hotel along with a delicious breakfast as you begin to immerse yourself in the vibrant, bustling daily life of Hanoi’s streets. After settling in, at around 2 PM, prepare for a cultural journey starting with a visit to Tran Quoc Pagoda, located on the scenic Golden Fish Island in West Lake. This pagoda, the oldest in Hanoi, dates back to the 6th century and offers a serene glimpse into Vietnam’s spiritual heritage. Your exploration continues to Hoa Lo Prison, historically known as “Maison Centrale,” built by the French between 1886 and 1901. The prison, once dubbed “A Hell on Earth,” now serves as a powerful war museum revealing

the struggles of the Vietnamese people during French colonial rule. To conclude your afternoon, take a leisurely walk around the picturesque Hoan Kiem Lake, soaking up the lively atmosphere while exploring shops and local attractions around the lake area. Spend your first night in Hanoi soaking in the city's charm.

Day 2 - Ha Long Bay Spectacle - Cruise Through Nature's Masterpiece

Your day begins with a hotel pick-up in Hanoi Old Quarter between 8 and 8:30 AM, followed by a comfortable expressway transfer to Ha Long Bay. After a short 20-minute rest stop around 10:30 AM, you will arrive at Tuan Chau Harbor by noon. Here, step aboard the Cozy Bay Premium Cruise for an unforgettable six-hour journey. Cruise through the breathtaking bay, famous for its striking limestone karsts, uninhabited islets, and rock formations creatively named by locals for their unique shapes. While enjoying a sumptuous buffet lunch on board, you will visit the enchanting Surprising Cave, home to an impressive display of stalagmites and stalactites that resemble various sea creatures. The adventure continues with a visit to Titop Island, where you can relax on a sandy beach or climb to the summit of Titop Peak for panoramic views of the stunning bayscape. Later, discover the beauty of Luon Cave's lagoon with kayaking or a bamboo boat ride. As the day winds down, enjoy a sunset party on the upper deck with red wine, tea, cakes, and lively music surrounded by awe-inspiring natural scenery. Return to Hanoi by bus in the evening, arriving back at your hotel around 9 to 9:30 PM.

Day 3 - From Hanoi to Danang - Discover the Dragon City's Nightlife Magic

After checking out from your Hanoi hotel, take a flight to Danang and check in to your hotel for a restful stay. At 4 PM, embark on an afternoon city tour starting with a visit to the iconic Dragon Bridge, which spans the Han River and symbolizes Danang's rapid modernization and growth. Continue to the lively Son Tra Night Market, a vibrant spot filled with colorful stalls offering souvenirs and local crafts. Enjoy exploring the market's atmosphere before returning to your hotel by 8 PM for an overnight stay in Danang.

Day 4 - Bana Hills Wonderland - Cable Cars, French Charm & The Golden Bridge

Your day starts with a morning pick-up from your hotel between 7:30 and 8:15 AM. En route to Bana Hills, you will stop at a traditional craft village to explore local artisan work

and prepare for your visit to the famous hill station. Arriving at Bana Hills around 9:45 AM, board the world's longest single-rope cable car that ascends to the enchanting French Village. Explore key attractions such as Lunar Castle and Eclipse Square, and experience the modern Mat Bay Theatre. Around midday, enjoy a delightful buffet lunch at one of the restaurants. In the afternoon, take in mini shows and photo opportunities near the sparkling golden Sunworld Globe, then venture into Fantasy Park for fun-filled activities. Later, board a short cable car ride to the iconic Golden Bridge, surrounded by blooming flower gardens and spectacular mountain views. Return to the cable car by late afternoon and transfer to your hotel in Hoian for an overnight stay.

Day 5 - Mystical Bay Mau Coconut Forest & Vibrant Arrival in Ho Chi Minh City

After breakfast at your hotel, your guide will pick you up at 8:30 AM and take you to Bay Mau Coconut Forest. Explore this enchanting forest, where you can hand-pick coconut leaves and watch artisans transform them into intricate jewelry. Witness traditional performances including the mesmerizing "casting a net to catch fish" dance and enjoy basket boat rides for crab fishing. Experience folk games such as hitting hanging clay pots and banana eating that bring local culture to life. After this immersive experience, return to your hotel, check out, and take a flight to Ho Chi Minh City. Upon arrival, meet your local guide and driver at Tan Son Nhat Airport who will transfer you to your hotel in the city center for overnight.

Day 6 - Mekong Delta Odyssey - Timeless Traditions and Tropical Treasures

Leave the energetic city behind early in the morning and travel to My Tho, a charming town nestled along the Mekong River. Visit the historic Vinh Trang Pagoda, dating back to the late 19th century, then board a traditional sampan to cruise through the serene river waterways. Explore four scenic islands named Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix, and Tortoise, each offering unique natural beauty. Stop at Unicorn Island for a walk through peaceful country lanes and orchards, enjoy fresh tropical fruits, and listen to folk songs performed by local residents. Discover family-run businesses and a honey-bee farm where you can taste honey tea and coconut candy. In the afternoon, take a cycling tour around Tan Thach village to meet locals and experience authentic rural life, or relax in a hammock while enjoying the cool breeze. Return to Ho Chi Minh City by early evening and spend your

night there.

Day 7 - Ho Chi Minh City Highlights - History, Culture & Fond Farewells

Begin your final day with a visit to the Independence Palace, also known as the Reunification Palace, an iconic landmark designed by architect Ngo Viet Thu. Explore the elegant French Colonial architecture including the Notre Dame Cathedral and the historic Central Post Office. Visit the War Remnants Museum to gain insight into Vietnam's turbulent history through its extensive exhibits on the Indochina wars. After sightseeing, return to your hotel to check out by noon. Your driver will then transfer you to the airport for your departure flight, carrying unforgettable memories of your incredible Vietnam journey.
